DARK ALE

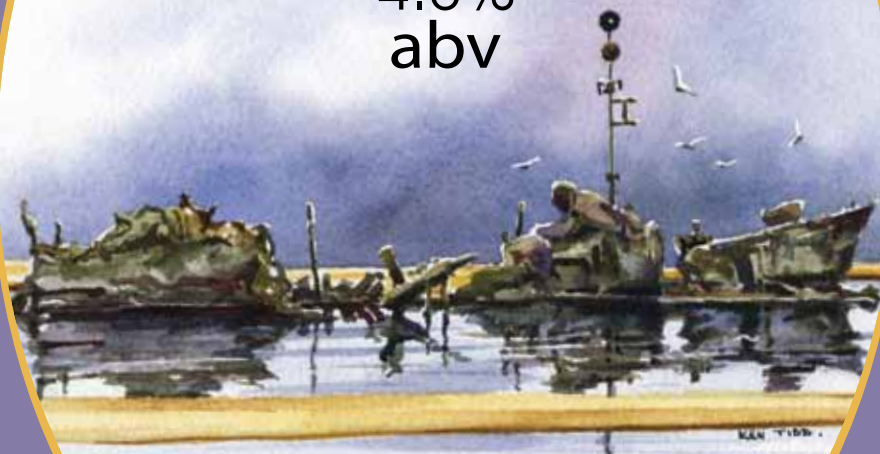
SS Vina is the shipwreck seen on Brancaster beach at low tide. Once a vessel in the merchant navy, it was towed up to the North Norfolk coast to provide target practice for the RAF before sinking in 1944, just off Scolt Head Island. Over the years the 'wreck' has become a landmark for all those visiting the coast. **The Wreck** is a **dark ale** made using malted **Maris Otter** barley from Branthill Farm, Wells-next-the-Sea. It is full-bodied and as robust as the wreck that stands on the beach. This label features original artwork by local artist **Ken Tidd**.

Best served cool, not chilled, carefully decanted into a clean glass, leaving the natural yeast sediment in the bottle.
