

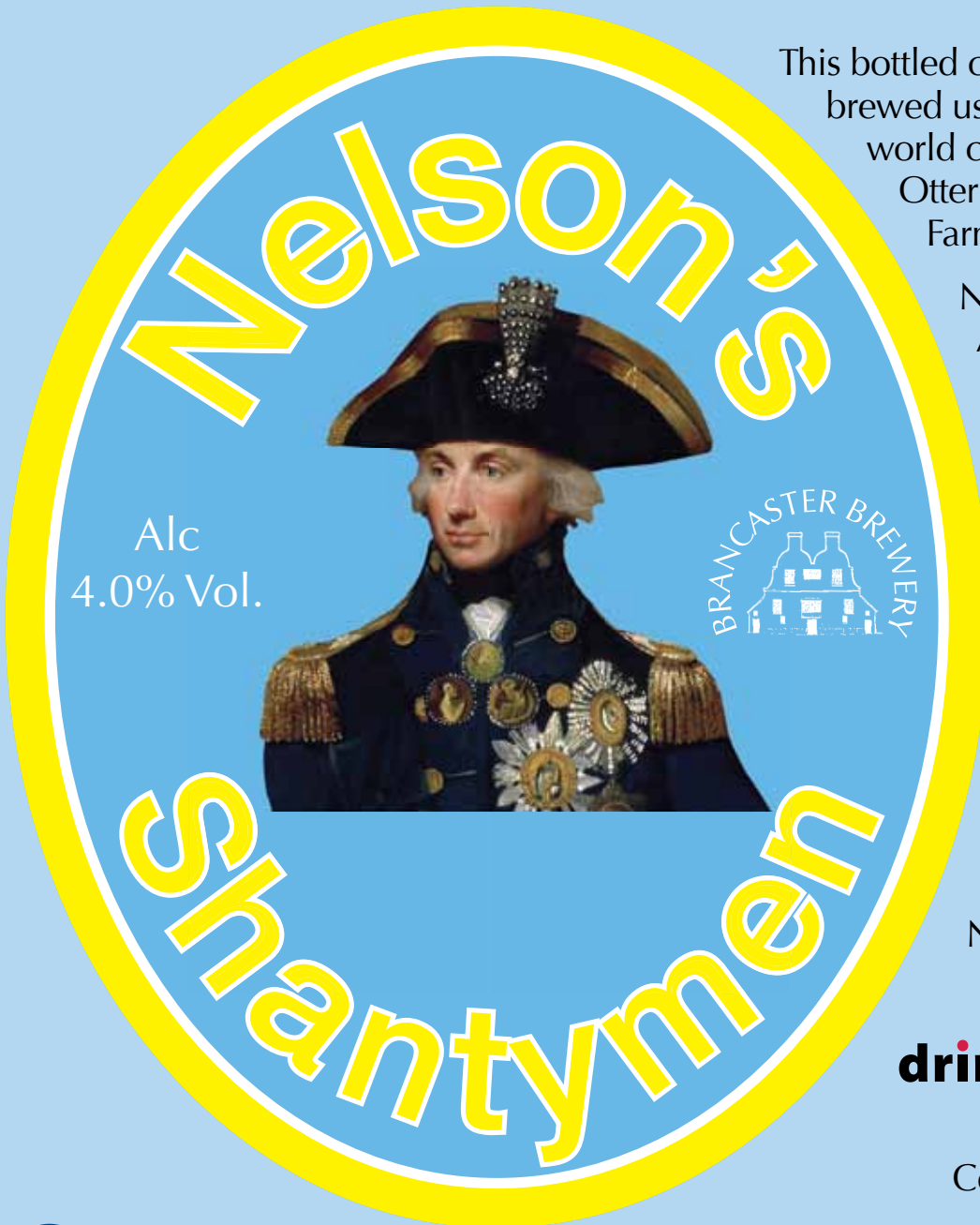


Brewed in Celebration of the Sea Shanty

The Sea Shanty is a type of collective folk song, and was performed on ships by fishermen, merchant sailors or whalers. They were sung to accompany the heavy, repetitive tasks of sail-hoisting and deck-scrubbing.

This bottled conditioned ale is brewed using Teddy Maufe's world class malted Marris Otter barley from Brantill Farm, Wells-next-the-Sea.

Nelson's Shantymen Ale, named after a non-profit group who raise money for local charities in the Norfolk area by singing Shanty songs, is a bitter ale full of flavour, perfectly balanced using British hops, with flavours of pine, orange & cedar, emulating the character of the Norfolk coast.
