### TASTING NOTES

#### BARSHAM BREWERY

##### Barsham Oaks 3.6%

Amber coloured, easy drinking bitter balanced with a Mosaic hop finish. Named after an old and beautiful woodland area on the Barsham Estate in Norfolk.

##### Norfolk Kiwi 3.8%

**Award Winning** easy drinking session bitter, brewed with the finest Norfolk Maris Otter barley and wheat, giving it a golden straw colour. Blended with generous helpings of English and New Zealand hops for that unique kiwi flavour and aroma.

#### BOUDICCA BREWING CO

##### Queen of Hops 3.7%

Refreshing Pale Ale with a satisfying lasting finish. Soft aroma, fruity, rounded, grassy, hints of marmalade.

##### Spiral Stout 4.6%

Full bodied with a spectrum of autumnal berries, coffee, dark chocolate with a gently lingering dry roast finish with a hint of smoke.

#### BRANCASTER BREWERY

##### Oystercatcher 4.4%

Brewed with three varieties of hops Pilot, Cascade and Brewer's Gold which gives a good body with a distinctly hoppy flavour.

##### Brancaster Best 3.8%

A refreshing session pale ale with a touch of citrus on the finish brewed using world class malted Maris Otter Norfolk barley.

#### ELGOODS BREWERY

##### Plum Porter 4.5%

A dark rich porter, with a note of roast malt and a fresh fruit aroma with plum flavours which enhance the dark full flavour.

##### Mamma Meerkat 3.7%

Pale gold delicately hopped, seasonal ale for June.

#### HUMPTY DUMPTY BREWERY

##### Branch Line 3.9%

A light chestnut bitter, brewed with a complex mix of malts for a rich body and English hops for a spicy, fruity aroma.

##### Little Sharpie 3.8%

A delicate hop aroma leads to a light clean tasting finish. **2013 Norwich and Norfolk CAMRA Gold medal - Bitter Category. 2009 Champion Bitter of Britain, Bronze.**

#### LACONS BREWERY

##### Encore 3.8%

Amber Ale packs a smooth citrus punch whilst balancing a dry pine and zesty flavour throughout. The finish is robust with a long bitterness. **Winner of 15 awards including 'World's Best Bitter Under 4%' at the 2015 World Beer Awards.**

##### Legacy 4.4%

Flavoursome blonde beer offers deep flavours. Predominant lemon and grapefruit aroma before a burst of lemon and lime floods the senses. A mellow finish leaves you wanting more. **Silver winner in Bitter & Pale Ale category at SIBA 2017.**

#### NORFOLK BREWHOUSE MOON GAZER

##### Jigfoot Norfolk Golden 4%

Golden, well-hopped character, citrus notes with a crisp finish.

##### Ostara Spring Ale 4.2%

Light, golden, soft bitterness with a lemon and orange citrus finish.

#### PANTHER BREWERY

##### Summer Daze, 3.9%

Extra Pale Ale brewed using finest locally grown malt, generously hopped with Motueka, Mosaic and German hops for a fruity lime finish.

##### Beast of the East, 5.5%

A premium amber IPA which uses a high level of New Zealand Hops giving a strong fruity punch.

#### WILD CRAFT BREWERY

##### Wild Summer 4.5%

Light but beautifully malty flavour which, when combined with Challenger and Golding hops, bursts with citrus and fruity aromas. An absolute must for a hot day, but good whatever the weather, this is England after all!

##### Wild Norfolk 4.2%

IPA taken up a level on the flavour scale by dry hopping with Azacca and Cascade hops to give a beer which is bursting with fruity, summery flavours.

#### WOLF BREWERY

##### Granny Wouldn't like it 4.8%

Dark red, rich and fruity this mighty beer has many awards to its name. A swirling mix of flavours produces a complex but satisfying experience.

##### Golden Jackal 3.7%

**Award Winning** hoppy, thirst quenching golden session bitter with a flowery nose and slightly citrus after taste. The hop flavour lasts right through to the bottom of the glass.

#### WOODFORDE'S BREWERY

##### Wherry 3.8%

**Award Winning, Supreme Champion Beer of Britain!** Mighty fresh and zesty, rich amber ale enjoys floods of flavours, as sweet malts clash with grapefruit hops and big floral aromas.

##### Volt 4.5%

A beer with some serious voltage! Best American hops are all piled into this beer! Tropical, citrus, floral and pine all found in a most aromatic brew.
